## ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement must be completed and returned to the school prior to enrollment.

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this agreement, under no circumstances shall Newbury School or its assignees be liable to the enrollee. The parent/responsible party is obligated to pay the tuition amount for participation in the program.

2. It is understood that all students/campers are required to follow the rules set forth by the staff and repeated violation of the rules can result in the student/camper being asked to leave the program.

3. The parent/responsible party assumes full responsibility for the actions or behavior of the student/camper and shall indemnify and hold harmless Newbury School and its employees from any claims arising from the actions and behavior of the enrollee.

4. I give permission to Newbury School to administer Tylenol to my child as needed and apply sunscreen, topical medication (vasoline, Neosporin) as needed and will sign a medication form that will be kept on file.

5. I give permission for my child:

6. With regard to allergies and/or medical conditions:

If not successful in either of the above, will do one or both of the following:

Call another physician or 911

Have the child transported to an emergency room in the company of a staff member.

8. Children participating in the program may not be dropped off earlier than the opening of the program and must be picked up by closing. A late fee is assessed for late pick-up at the rate of \$25.00 for the first 10 minutes late and \$1.00 per minute for additional time. In consideration of the staff, repeated late pick-ups can result in the child being asked to leave the program.
